ENGLISH OFFICIAL VERSION

36. STRESSES that the roll out of new technologies such as 5G/6G should preserve the abilities of law enforcement authorities, security authorities and the judiciary to perform their legitimate functions effectively. TAKES into account the international guidelines concerning the health impact of electromagnetic fields. EXPRESSES the importance of fighting against the spread of misinformation related to 5G networks, with special regard to false claims that such networks constitute a health threat or are linked to COVID-19.

36. STRESSES that, **in the context of** the roll out of new technologies such as 5G/6G, **it is appropriate to** preserve the abilities of **repressive*** authorities, security services and the court system to perform their legitimate functions effectively. TAKES into account the international guidelines concerning the health impact of electromagnetic fields. EXPRESSES the importance of **combatting** the spread of misinformation relating to 5G networks, especially with regard to false claims that such networks constitute a health threat or are linked to COVID-19.

**May officially be translated as “law enforcement authorities”, but “repressive” is also a legitimate translation and in this context may better convey the intention of the authors, depending on which language was the original language of the document, which is unknown.*

SOULIGNE que, dans le cadre du déploiement de nouvelles technologies telles que la 5G/6G, il convient de préserver les capacités des autorités répressives, des services de sécurité et de l'appareil judiciaire à exercer leurs fonctions légitimes efficacement; TIENT COMPTE des lignes directrices internationales concernant les effets des champs électromagnétiques sur la santé; RELEVÉ qu'il importe de lutter contre la diffusion de mésinformations concernant les réseaux 5G, surtout eu égard aux allégations fallacieuses selon lesquelles ces réseaux constituerait une menace pour la santé ou seraient liés à la COVID-19;
